### **“Juridical Review The Inheritance Rights of The Child Who Born by Unregistered Marriage”**

The registration of marriage is an important element to indicate the validity of a marriage according to existed regulation. In fact, there are still many people who do not register their marriages at the civil registration office and this has a legal effect that appears from the marriage. A child who was born from unregistered marriage have a status as an extramarital child or illegitimate child and this affects to the rights that a child should get, for example, the inheritance rights that a child should get as a legitimate child.

The research question is regarding how the legal consequences of unregistered marriage and what legal steps can be taken for a child from unregistered marriage to obtain their inheritance rights. The purpose of this research is to know, understand and analyze the inheritance rights and legal steps that can be taken by a child from unregistered marriage to obtain their inheritance rights. The type of research is in the form of a Normative Legal Research with a Statute and Case Approach. The legal materials are obtained from the literature study.

Based on the results of research, it can be seen that unregistered marriages have legal consequences that can harm the rights of the wife and the child from the marriage, the marriage considered illegal by the law, the wife could not demand her civil rights in a legal way, a child who born by unregistered marriage also considered by illegitimate child by the law and do not have civil relationships with his biologic father, but a child from unregistered marriages still have the opportunity to obtain their rights by recognizing and endorsing from the biologic father of the child.
