THE MECHANICAL FOR ARRESTING AND DETAINING PERPETRATORS OF TERRORISM CRIME UNDER INDONESIAN LAW

Acts of terorism continue to develop and causing legal problems therefore the government decides to reform the former anti-terorism act. Following the terorist attack that took place in Jakarta in 2016, the government started an effort to reform anti-terorism act in order to reconcile the legislations with the current development of terorism. After 2 years of progress, the new legislations regarding anti-terorism act is finally approved by the legislative. The new legislation expands the period of time for the arrest and detention of suspected perpetrator of criminal act of terrorism.
