JURIDICAL REVIEW OF THE INDONESIAN GOVERNMENT LEGAL PROTECTION AGAINST MIGRANT WORKERS RELATED TO THE ILO CONVENTION Number. 19, Number. 29, and Number. 111.

Indonesia is a country that has a very large population but with a disproportionate number of jobs, because of this many Indonesians are unemployed. One of the solutions to this problem is to carry out migration and seek work in other countries. Erwiana Sulistyaningsih, an Indonesian citizen who worked in Hong Kong as a migrant worker is one of many cases of Indonesian migrant workers abroad that need protection. Indonesia and Hong Kong are two countries that are members of the International Labor Organization or ILO which have regulations in the form of a Convention. Indonesia and Hong Kong also have international labor and labor protection laws.
