As has been explained that the provisions of the Act relating to the ITE freedom of speech is only regulated in one article and there are only a prohibition without rights. Based on that, then that provision it is still obscurity. So requires setting Further the Act ITE. As human rights are also included within the political right individual and personal rights, freedom of expression must be absolute protected and cannot be reduced. But considering that the right is also raise an obligation to honor and respect the rights of others, the implementation of these rights may be restricted by law. While the ITE Law there is no clear restrictions regarding them.
