

ABSTRACT

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MULTIMEDIA BASED OF INTERACTIVE APPLICATION ON BASIC PIANO LEARNING

The building of this application is aimed at providing an alternative way for learning piano particularly for those who are much interested in this activity but just too busy to take a piano course.

There are 35 questionnaires distributed to respondents within age 15 – 30 years. These questionnaires are used to gain some informations needed in developing the application, such as what kind of information are supposed to be included in the application. Based on the evaluation of those questionnaires the application are designed to be useful and would operates easily.

This interactive application is a new way of learning a piano lesson, not merely the theory but there also some partitures that user could listen to included in this application.
