PENGARUH PERCEIVED SOCIAL SUPPORT TERHADAP PSYCHOLOGICAL WELL BEING PADA IBU DENGAN ANAK AUTISM SPECTRUM DISORDER DI JABODETABEK

Abstract: - *Children with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) require special attention during their development. A mother with a child with ASD needs support in raising her child. One of the supports needed is social support so that the psychological and physical well-being of mothers with children with ASD can be maintained. This study aims to find out whether perceived social support affects the psychological well-being of mothers who have children with ASD in the Greater Jakarta area. This study uses The Multidimensional Scale of Perceived Social Support and the Ryff Psychological Well-Being Scale. The results showed no influence between perceived social support on psychological well-being in mothers with children with ASD in Jabodetabek.*

Abstrak Anak dengan *Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD)* membutuhkan perhatian khusus selama masa perkembangannya. Seorang ibu yang memiliki anak dengan *ASD* memerlukan dukungan dalam mengasuh anaknya. Salah satu dukungan yang dimaksud adalah dukungan sosial, agar kesejahteraan psikis dan fisik ibu yang memiliki anak dengan *ASD* dapat tetap terjaga. Penelitian ini ingin mengetahui apakah *perceived social support* mempengaruhi *psychological well-being* pada ibu yang memiliki anak dengan *ASD* di Jabodetabek. Penelitian ini menggunakan alat ukur *The Multidimensional Scale of Perceived Social Support* dan *The Ryff Psychological Well Being Scale*. Hasil penelitian ini menemukan bahwa tidak terdapat pengaruh antara *perceived social support* terhadap *psychological well-being* pada ibu yang memiliki anak dengan *ASD* di Jabodetabek.
