Dalam kehidupan berbangsa dan bernegara, kerja sama antarnegara merupakan suatu hal yang tak dapat terelakan. Setiap negara memiliki tujuan dan kebutuhannya masing-masing, namun dalam upaya untuk mencapai hal tersebut, tiap negara dihadapkan dengan berbagai macam permasalahan dan tantangan. Maka dari itu diperlukan kerja sama antarnegara guna untuk mencapai hal yang diinginkan, serta mengeliminasi berbagai macam tantangan dan permasalahan yang ada. Salah satu interaksi dan kerja sama antar negara yang menarik untuk dibahas adalah mengenai kerja sama antara Amerika Serikat dengan Meksiko. Selama dua abad menjalin interaksi, Amerika Serikat dan Meksiko telah melewati berbagai macam situasi dan dinamika politik, termasuk *drug trafficking*, dan *narcoterrorism*. Dalam upaya untuk mengatasi permasalahan tersebut, serta untuk merayakan 200 tahun kerja sama mereka, Amerika Serikat dan Meksiko membuat suatu konsep kerangka kerja sama yang dinamakan Bicentennial Framework for Security, Public Health, and Safe Community. Di dalam penelitian ini, konsep kerangka kerja sama ini dibahas dan diulas dengan perspektif Neoliberalisme, Interdependensi, dan *Common Interest*. Dalam penelitian ini, penelitian juga akan menggunakan pendekatan kualitatif dengan metode pengumpulan data sekunder untuk memperkaya informasi mengenai kerja sama Amerika Serikat dengan Meksiko melalui Bicentennial Framework for Security, Public Health, and Safe Community. Hasil penelitian ini menunjukkan bahwa Amerika Serikat dan Meksiko menunjukkan keseriusan mereka tidak hanya dalam memberantas *drug trafficking* dan *narcoterrorism*, tetapi juga menyediakan fasilitas dan perlindungan yang lebih baik bagi masyarakat.

Cooperation between countries is something that cannot be avoided.
